



Farm Credit Scholarship Program

Farm Credit Mid-America offers 26 scholarships at \$1,500 each and 26 scholarships at \$1,000 each year. Scholarships are open to Farm Credit customers, children of customers or grandchildren of customers. The application and other requirements are found on the next three tabs of this document. Any career or major is eligible to apply. However, a preference will be given to those students who plan to pursue an ag-related career. Farm Credit also offers scholarships at universities in Indiana, Ohio, Kentucky and Tennessee as well as through state 4-H and FFA programs. GUIDELINES AND ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships are awarded based on academic record, leadership qualities and community involvement.

Incoming college freshman, sophomore, junior or senior, in good standing for the year scholarship is received

Plan to attend any higher education institution within the next year (2-year and 4-year universities)

Cumulative grade point average of 3.0 is preferred

Ag background or work-related experience in agriculture

Be a customer of Farm Credit Mid-America, child or grandchild of a Farm Credit Mid-America

Must submit an essay on how you plan to use your major in the chosen career (tab 4 of this application)

Winner will be invited to make a brief presentation at an Farm Credit Customer Appreciation Event

Graduating high school seniors are eligible to apply

Employees or children of employees and directors or children of directors are not eligible to apply
